

SHAYLA WIGAND ARTIST STATEMENT

I investigate mixed media abstract paintings, Mono-prints, and new media. My work reflects an active response to the presence and atmosphere of worship. I attempt to distill spiritual language into visual language. I view all my activity as a conversation with God where an exchange takes place. I feel this exchange occurs in an atmosphere of spiritual tension. I believe the best way to comprehend the mysteries of the unexplainable is to steward them into the visual language of abstraction. In my work I preserve the presence that reflects the atmosphere inherent in its creation. Through the mysterious aspects of my practice, I offer food for the spirit and illuminate the idea that there is more to be experienced in the spirit than in the flesh.

ALEXIS LYNN BAKER ARTIST STATEMENT

I am an artist dedicated to breaching my own comfort limits. My work is a reflection of personal exploration; memories, dreams, and the way they impose themselves into my daily life. My latest abstract body of work exhibited in the dual show, *Transformed*, ranges from small to large works on canvas or other found sub-straights. These pieces expose stories about my life, and how these moments can have such impact and relevance.

Translucency within the silk represents the willingness of being transparent about my life. However, it also acts as a veil to create mystery and romanticism; or even hide things I am not ready to admit or share, entirely. Intense red is carried throughout, to unify the body of work and signify notions of empowerment, through the unbound nature of the color. When using found objects, I channel the idea of history to represent different timelines of my life. The physicality of this line is carried throughout, as a red thread, bridged behind a veil, threaded, or simply exposed. Each represents a moment or a literal timeline of an experience. I have nightmares that haunt me through the day. They stain my work conceptually and physically. But these are not dreams, they're memories. Within the context of the exhibition, *Transformed*, my work symbolizes the timeline of uncertainty within self exploration, that comes before the realization of God and His word.

ALEXIS LYNN BAKER BIO

Alexis Lynn Baker (b. 1996, United States) attends Savannah College of Art and Design to receive a bachelor's degree in painting, with a minor in printmaking and drawing, in spring of 2020. After graduating, Alexis intends on later getting a master's degree in printmaking at University of Tennessee located in Knoxville. Alexis's conceptual process is directed toward exposing her memories and dreams, and using it to evoke change and transformation. Using found objects, she channels the idea of history to represent these different timelines of her life. Red is carried through each piece to unify the found object works, to Alexis's acrylic mixed media paintings. These tend to be very minimal and abstract; focusing on the fluidity of motion, and the color red and its impressions on emotion. Exhibiting works from France to Savannah, GA, she has been in eight group exhibitions since the fall of 2018.
